Although the fire looks like it's just across the I-90 it's actually 15-20 miles Southwest of Sunlight Waters & West of Keenen Meadows off Manastash Creek Road. Fire Chief DJ Evans commented today at 5pm "he's watching it closely, and it seems to him they have it pinned down to about 50 square acres." His advice "is to be extra safe." Volunteers Crucial to the Community

Major improvements to SLWCC facilities have been accomplished this year due to the efforts of a handful of dedicated community volunteers. Fred Niemi served as the project manager for the reconstruction of the clubhouse entries. This will make the facility ADA-compliant, making it easier for those with disabilities to access the clubhouse. Construction was completed on August 8th, with Fred logging over 275 hours of volunteer time on the project. Jerry and Letha Ihrke, Randy and Carol Nelson and Teddi Ryland contributed their time to repair and resurface the pool, which reopened in July. Dan Fisher is the project manager for community road improvements and maintenance, overseeing this year's work that was completed in July. Dan will also serve as a Community Standards volunteer in 2013. Jerry Ihrke has agreed to be our Facility Maintenance Manager, overseeing clubhouse maintenance and projects like the clubhouse doors and French drain. Carrie Niemi is donating her time as SLWCC's representative in an effort to recover damages from PSE. Randy and Carol Nelson painted the clubhouse entries last Saturday. The Board and the community thanks all of you!!

The revised bylaws have been notarized and recorded with the county, they will be posted on the website and copies are available in the SLWCC office.

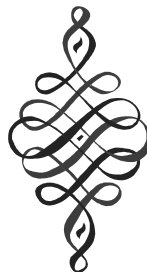
