The Chief wants Sunlight Waters residents to know that it is time to make your home and property FireWise.

Keep trees trimmed so branches are 10-12 feet off the ground, clear debris and firewood at least 30 feet from your home, clean roofs and under decks, clear rain gutters and keep grasses and weeds down. The FireWise designation for SLWCC has been renewed for 2014. This year's Chipper Program was a great success thanks to those who participated!

The 2014 annual meeting was held on May 17th, with approximately 70 people in attendance. There were more owners than usual willing to be involved in the governance of the community, resulting in a whopping seven members being elected to the Board. Longtime volunteer Dan Fisher was chosen as President and Bonny McCurdie as Treasurer. Dave Korpi, Dava Ihrke, and Alice Huddleson continue as V.P., Secretary and Trustee, respectively. Prior to the meeting Suzanne Wade and the Kittitas County Conservation District hosted a barbecue and FireWise seminar for the community. The new Board of Trustees and the Community wish to thank Randy Nelson for sitting in as 2013 President, and departing Trustees River Melos and Alan Bedard for their service to the community.

2014 Improvements: The Board brought back Roadtek to continue road improvements. This year, they graded, graveled and double chip-sealed Ridge Loop Road. Roadtek also graded and graveled Clubhouse Road at no cost to the community. The Board hired Kodiak Industrial Solutions to resurface the pool. They will be out again at the end of the summer to do more work. The Board and Community wishes to thank Dan Fisher for overseeing both of these projects. The Canal Bridge was rehabilitated this summer with an all-new bridge deck. Mike Quiett oversaw the work, which was done in partnership with the KRD. Thanks for your help Mike!
