

June 10 board meeting.  
Call to order at 10:00

Appointment of James Ihrke to position of Secretary.

Motion to approve the Treasure's report passed unanimously.

Upcoming expenditures: Propane, roads, tree cutting.

SLWCC is owed \$109,000 in back dues and fines, \$72,000 of which is More than 90 days in arrears.

Two lots were sold by SLWCC. This money is intended to be used to purchase lien properties within SLWCC up for tax auction in cases where SLWCC's lien would otherwise be forfeited.

Discrepancy/error on the budget handout at the Annual Meeting needs to be clarified and sent out on the news letter.

No new correspondence to report.

No executive session was held.

Road Tech is looking into speed deterrent options for SLWCC private roads.

Two new neighbors outside of SLWCC who share our access roads have agreed to contribute financially to road maintenance.

Felling of dangerous trees by the lakes will begin June 22<sup>nd</sup> by Wilderness Ridge Tree services.

Volunteer Projects were discussed.

The board moved to offer \$20/hour in back dues forgiveness for community project labor. The motion was seconded and tabled.

The following list of topics were requested to be included in the upcoming newsletter: Use of the lakes, maintain your easement, balance sheet clarification, increased speed enforcement, control your dogs.
